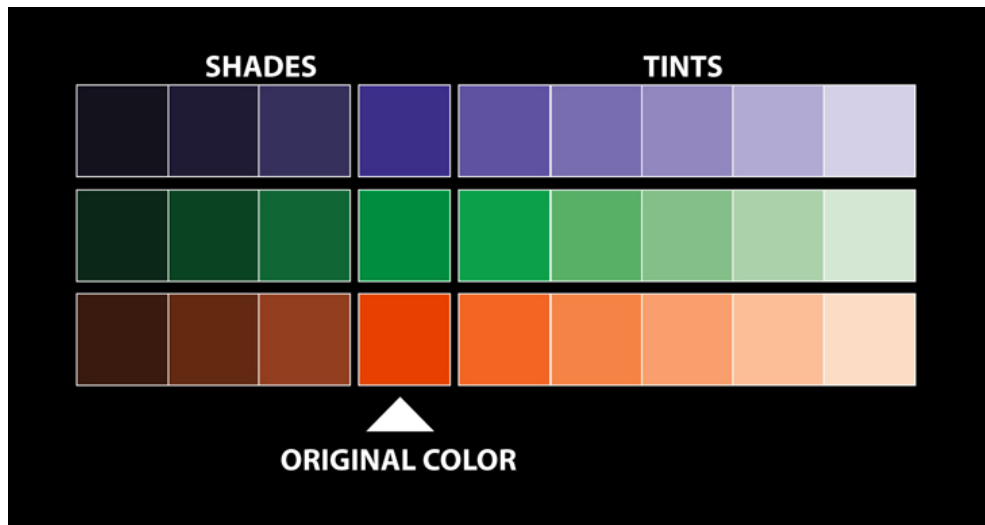

### Wallpaper Color Scheme



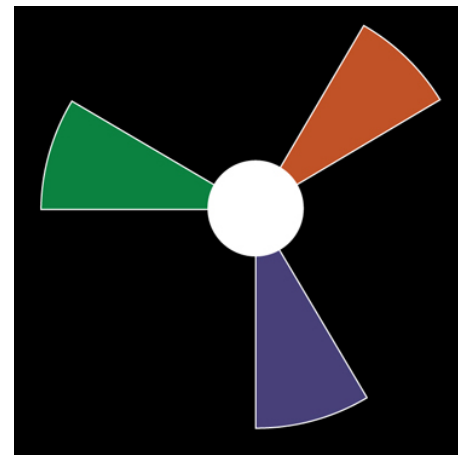
### Assignment Description

Mix and paint your color palette for your Wallpaper Pattern.

### Supplies Needed

You will need the following supplies for this assignment:

- Color Scheme Sheet (Provided)
- Acrylic Paints (Red, Yellow, Blue)
- Small Paint Brush
- White and Black Acrylic Paint (Provided)
- Black Sharpie Marker



### Creative Process

1. Choose one of the following Color Schemes
  - Monochromatic
  - Analogous
  - Complementary
  - Split Complementary
  - Triadic
2. Mix and paint 100% of the original colors of your chosen Color Scheme.
3. Mix and paint 5 Tints of the original colors in your chosen Color Scheme.
4. Mix and paint 3 Shades of the original colors in your chosen Color Scheme.
5. When all mixing and painting has been completed, go over black lines with a black sharpie and paint white over any paint outside of the color boxes.
